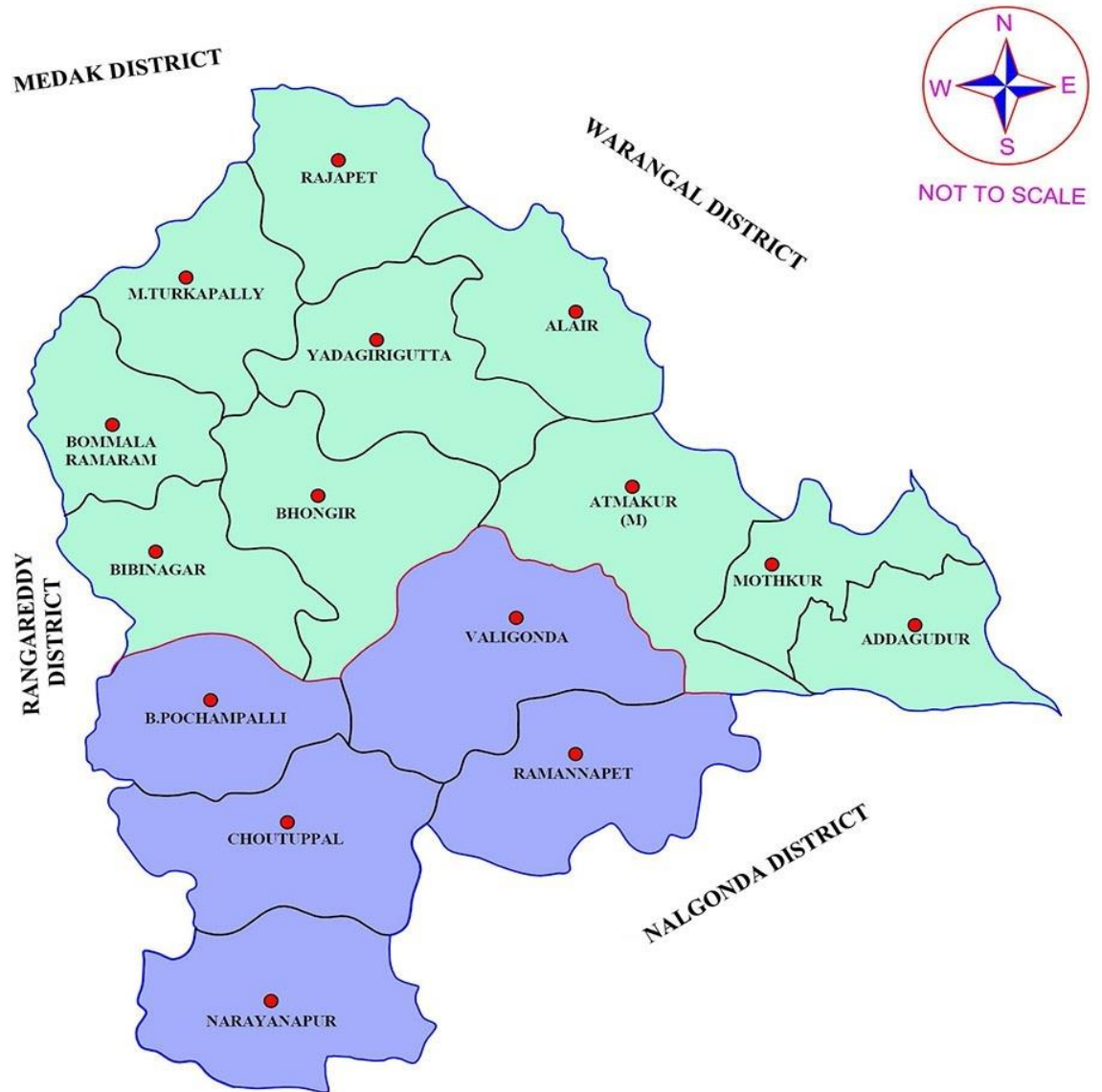


WELCOME NOTE TO POTENTIAL ENTREPRENEURS

The district has the advantage of being in the close proximity of the Cosmopolitan cities (Hyderabad and Secunderabad) and is well connected with road (ORR) and rail network. The district has huge potential as it is abetting the Outer Ring road and as a policy of the state government, all the manufacturing industries especially orange and red category industries have to necessarily shift their units from within the ORR to the areas outside the ORR. So all the existing industries can set up their new/ expansion or shift their manufacturing base to this district keeping in view the infrastructure facilities viz., road, rail and airport, Hospitals, Schools and Engineering colleges availability of skilled workers at reasonable wages. The district is close to markets(Hyderabad and Secunderabad). Further the proposed Industrial corridor-The Hyderabad-Warangal Industrial Corridor passes through the district. The Yadagirigutta temple is the major temple of the state attracting thousands of devotees everyday.

a) General Profile

Location:The District head quartered at Bhongir which is located at 17.5035° N, 78.8892° E

The district is divided into two Revenue divisions for administration purpose namely Bhongir Division and Choutuppal Division

The district comprises of 16 mandals namely Addaguduru, Alair, Atmakur(M),Bibinagar, Bhongir, Bommaramaram, Motakondur, Mothkur, Rajapet, Yadagirigutta, Valigonda, Turkapally B. Pochampally, Choutuppal, Narayanpur, Ramannapet.

Bhongir is the Major town in the District.

The district enjoys semi-arid type of climate with a moderate rainfall

Black cotton soil, Morrums and Red soil is the most common type of soil available in the district

The district is well connected by road and Railways. Yadadri also known as Yadagirigutta is a popular Hindu temple situated on a hillock in Yadagirigutta. It is about 70 Kilometers from Hyderabad on the Hyderabad-Warangal Highway. The temple is an abode of Narasimha Swamy, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu.. As it is located at a distance of about 60 km from the Hyderabad, the flow of devotees / pilgrims visiting the temple for worship is very high. Telangana government is planning to develop Yadadri into a major religious tourist destination. In few months from now, it would become the most sought after tourist and pilgrimage centre. Bhongir fort, which stands on a monolithic rock, is considered a popular tourist destination and coupled with a thrilling climbing experience. The town of Bhuvanagiri/Bhongir derives its name from this splendid fort.

A new Industrial corridor is proposed from Hyderabad to Warangal which passes through the heart of the district. It is very near to the Capital city and the International Airport. River Musi, local tanks and borewells are the major sources of agriculture which is the main occupation of the people in the rural areas of the district. Textile industry is also one of the focal points of the district. Pochampally handloom products are of national and international repute. Kolanupaka Jain Mandir at Kolanupaka village, near Aler town is a 2000-year old temple. The temple which is embellished with beautiful images of Tirthankaras. is an important pilgrimage center for Svetambara Jains of South India. Kolanupaka Museum exhibits exquisite artifacts from the numerous historical monuments in Kolanupaka.

Bhongir Industrial Park

Industrial Park at Bhongir of Nalgonda District was established in the year 1981 by the Corporation. The Industrial Park is developed in an area of 60.00 Acres, situated at a distance of 5 Kms from Bhongir Town on Hyderabad – Warangal State Highway. 83 plots are developed and allotted in this Industrial park. The major industrial activities in the park are Aluminum Utensils, Fine Chemical Furniture, Pharmaceuticals, HDPE Pipes, Paper Products, Plastic, Handicrafts and General Engineering Units.
